Grape Variety: Petite Sirah & Cabernet Sauvignon

Region: Napa Valley

Winemaking Notes:

Fermented in small stainless steel tanks Aged in 100% French oak

- 50% new oak

- aged for 20 months

Tasting Notes: This bold and powerful wine is a blend of 38% Petite Sirah from Rutherford and 62% Cabernet Sauvignon from St Helena. This wine, dark purple in color, brings intensity with its flavors of densely rich red and black fruits, and hints of spice and cedar. The palate continues with its notes of bold fruits and underlying earthiness that layer together with formidable tannins to create deep flavor and its huge finish! This opulent red blend will age well through the years.

What Knockout Signifies: An intense, rich and impactful bottle of wine, Knockout will steal the show. This delectable wine gets its power and strength from a core of Petite Sirah which is spicy and intense in the glass, while the Cabernet Sauvignon adds finesse and grace. The uncommon pairing of intense and rich Petite Sirah with the plushness of Cabernet Sauvignon is a winning combination!
