CAPTIVATING - BEGUILING - MYSTIFYING

GRAPE VARIETY: Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Merlot

REGION: Napa Valley, California

WINEMAKING NOTES: Aged in 18-19 months in French oak - 36% new French (Demptos, Ermitage, Seg Moreau). Fermentation (all extended maceration) on skins for 38 days (range of 22 - 47 days). This vintage is a blend of four vineyards, the Cabernet Franc coming from the east sides of Oakville (along with the Merlot) and St. Helena, and the Cabernet Sauvignon from Spring Mountain. Vegan, bottled unfined and unfiltered.

Alcohol: 15% | pH: 3.67 | T/A: 6.4 g/L

TASTING NOTES: Bold yet nuanced, The Charmer utilizes fruit from three different vineyards creating a powerful wine. The Cabernet Sauvignon found in the hills above Rutherford gives The Charmer its structure and a fruit-forward focus along with notes of cassis and black cherry. Cabernet Franc from Calistoga expresses perfumy aromatics and balanced herb, while the Merlot from Oak Knoll delivers fully ripe berries and earth layered over a long finish.

WHAT THE CHARMER SIGNIFIES: Made in a Claret style with Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, and just a touch of Merlot, The Charmer lies in wait to express its bold aromas and medium ruby coloring. Behind each twist and turn lies a diversity of tastes and experiences, making it all too easy to get caught up and fall, completely, for The Charmer.

The Charmer is CAPTIVATING from the first sight to the very last sip. Lingering in its finish, this Napa Valley Red Wine is BEGUILING and envelops the senses of all who dare cross its path. Once willingly ensnared, succumb to the MYSTIFYING properties possessed within each bottle.
