GRAPE VARIETY: Cabernet Sauvignon

REGION: Napa Valley, California

WINEMAKING NOTES: Aged 18-19 months in small French oak barrels - 56% new French (Demptos, Ermitage, Baron). Fermentation (all extended maceration) on skins for 40 days. Two of the three vineyards were harvested on fruit days, and one on a root day (to bring out more tannin and power) and was bottled on a fruit day. Vegan, bottled unfined and unfiltered
Alcohol: 14.5% | pH: 3.61 | T/A: 6.1 g/L

TASTING NOTES: This vintage is an artful blend of three vineyards—81% sourced from St. Helena and 19% from Oakville. N°10 astonishes with a captivating, gem-like purple hue. With a delightful bouquet of baked plums, a hint of cinnamon, and opulent earthiness, this wine is resolute displaying velvety tannins and a daringly invigorating freshness.

WHAT THE NUMBER 10 SIGNIFIES: The number 10 throughout history has always represented the concept of wholeness, soundness and being complete. This wine was uniquely designed to represent all that Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is renowned for: structure, balance and power. It is a perfect 10!

For Jean-Charles Boisset, the N° 10 Cabernet Sauvignon must not only age well into the future, it must be DECADENT in the present. It must have a commanding structure, yet have flavors that are HEDONISTIC. But above all, N° 10 must always have a dramatic personality. It is never tamed and predictable. N° 10 is NOBLE.
