GRAPE VARIETY: Sauvignon Blanc & Sémillon

REGION: Napa Valley, California

WINEMAKING NOTES: Sourced exclusively from our St. Helena Estate vineyards, where well-drained loam soils promote balanced vine growth and concentrated fruit expression. Sauvignon Blanc was fermented in neutral French oak barrels to enhance complexity, while Sémillon was fermented in stainless steel to preserve freshness and texture. The wines were aged sur lie for 11 months with regular bâtonnage, building richness, depth, and a creamy mouthfeel before blending and bottling.

Alcohol: 13.5% | pH: 3.17 | T/A: 6.9 g/L

TASTING NOTES: The nose opens with enticing aromas of Meyer lemon blossom, white nectarine, and honeysuckle, layered with notes of fresh pear, and kaffir lime. On the palate, vibrant flavors of golden apple, juicy cantaloupe, and preserved citrus unfold with remarkable purity and finesse. Nuances of almond cream and delicate pastry add complexity, while a thread of mineral freshness carries through to a long, refined finish. Bright, seamless acidity lends energy and balance, leaving a lasting impression of elegance and vitality.

WHAT THE NUMBER 16 SIGNIFIES: Jean-Charles grew up in Burgundy, France and at the age of 16 he visited the Bordeaux region for the first time. He forever remembers his first taste of the crisp white wine blends and it inspired the creation of N°16, an extraordinary Napa Valley blend of Sauvignon Blanc and Semillon.
