



## PINOT NOIR West Sonoma Coast

BRAVE. INCEPTIVE. ENLIGHTENED.

GRAPE VARIETY: Pinot Noir

REGION: West Sonoma Coast, California

WINEMAKING NOTES: Aged in French oak barrels - 35% new oak. Malolactic fermentation.

Alcohol: 14.5% | pH: 3.71 T/A: 7.2 g/L

TASTING NOTES: Complex and energetic, the first vintage of our N°19 leaps out of the glass eager to demonstrate its velvety texture and coastal influence. The cooler daytime temperature paired with the warmer lows at night have allowed the grapes to ripen at a slower pace and reach peak maturity with lower sugar levels and fresh acidity. On the nose, blueberry and plum arise with a note of black pepper and continue to drape across the palate with additional red fruit for a luxurious and leisurely finish. An absolute stunner and welcomed addition to the JCB Pinot Noir line-up.

WHAT THE NUMBER 19 SIGNIFIES: A blend of fate and timing brought our N°19 into fruition. This West Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir hails from the newly established 19th American Viticultural Area (AVA) in Sonoma County and beautifully demonstrates the riches this appellation can produce.

Testing the limits and dictated by its coastal proximity, our N°19 Pinot Noir is BRAVE with its unyielding climatic characteristics and bright acidity. INCEPTIVE and displaying moderate alcohol and pure flavors, N°19 is ENLIGHTENED and pushes the boundaries previously known by this varietal
