GRAPE VARIETY: Chardonnay and Pinot Noir

REGION: Burgundy

WINEMAKING NOTES: 2017 was an early harvest with climatic events: frost in the spring, hail in the summer and a lack of rain at the end of the season.

Alcohol: 12% | Dosage: 6 g/L Brut

TASTING NOTES: Light yellow color with long-lasting bubbles and a generous collar of foam around the glass. A highly expressive nose featuring aromas of honey and blood peach. Vanilla notes blend together with toast to contribute to a highly complex bouquet. A bold, powerful attack with largely mineral-driven notes marrying nicely with woody flavours. A particularly rich finish underlines just how beautifully-balanced this wine is. JCB N°8 is straightforward, powerful and long on the palate, giving an impressive vitality to the wine.

WHAT THE NUMBER 8 SIGNIFIES: Harmonious, elegant and balanced...the quintessential harmony between Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. JCB N°8 is the perfect equilibrium between the ultimate, most noble grapes from Burgundy. It is the yin and the yang, both sophisticated and complex.

This perfectly **BALANCED** blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay honors the long history of producing sparkling wine in Burgundy. **REBELLIOUS** by nature, Jean-Charles is well respected for making **SOPHISTICATED** and elegant bubbles.
